May 14, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 9AM with 49 attending by Joe our greeter who welcomed all and advised since we are not riding today due to the weather we will have a member profile.

Joe then led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Today's profile is on our Treasurer Fran Maineri. Fran was born in Southington CT in 1948. He has lived in CT and NH his entire life. While he was educated to be a school teacher, he never taught. He started out as a programmer in the dinosaur age of computers back when programs were run from trays of cards. He spent the next 26 years working in corporate America working first in the insurance industry and then for a manufacturing company that supported the automobile industry with oil seals. He worked in areas related to finance and when he left the company in 1998 he was the payroll and benefits manager overseeing an employee population of over 5000 in 5 states. After that, he started 3 different businesses. The first was a commercial embroidery business that was taken over by his wife Karen, who ran it successfully for 20 years prior to selling it and retiring. The second was a short lived bakery and the third was a payroll services company which had a client base of nearly 200 small businesses. He sold that business in 2013 and retired. He also worked for a Laconia based accounting firm specializing in tax accounting between the 2nd and 3rd business. He never served in the military. He has been married to Karen for 47 years and has 2 children and 4 grandchildren. He has 1 sister. He has been working hard at retirement since 2013 and enjoying all the things that had slipped through the cracks since he was 20 years old. He bought his first motorcycle at 21-1970 Suzuki, first a street bike and then a dirt bike. He has owned 5 motorcycles. Fran has been a HOG member 8 years. His hobbies are hiking, snowshoeing, gardening, photography and bushwhacking. He and his wife have hiked the 100 highest New England and NH mountains. He has also hiked NH's 4000 mountains in the winter. He has hiked NH's 4000' in a single winter season and is currently working on the NE 100 highest in a single winter season. He has competed in track and field and road races since high school and at age 50 or 51 he competed in the National Masters Track and Field Championships at the University of Oregon and again at LSU in Baton Rouge LA. He is happy to remain living in NH, but would like to visit all the National Parks. The remaining item on his bucket list is he would like to find the 25th hour of the day so he would have more time to do everything he hasn't had the chance to do yet. Fran has no regrets and his favorite food is whatever italian dish he is currently eating. Fran lives in New Hampton.
